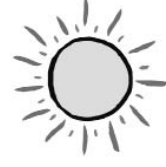
## Bass Tournament to benefit Michael Hooper

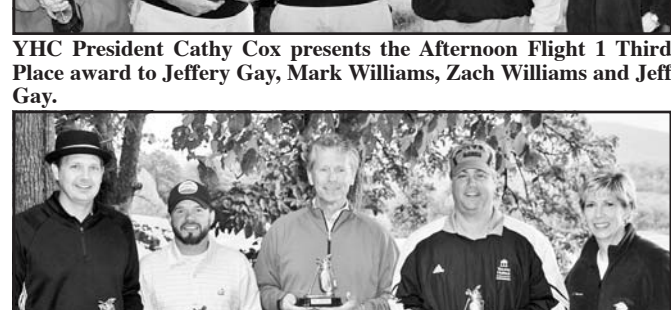
