Indians move up one in Power Rankings following sweep of Tallulah

Towns County falls 14-4 to Hebron despite early 1-0 lead

Towns County (8-13) won two-of-three last week capped off by a two-game sweep of Tallulah Falls that saw Will DeVries and Zach Davenport fire consecutive shutouts as the Indians prevailed 10-0 and 2-0.

DeVries' two-hit, eightstrikeout outing came in a 10-0 Towns County victory that saw the Indians score two in the second, third and fourth innings before putting Tallulah away with four in the sixth.

DeVries went 2-for-3 at the plate with a double, 2 RBIs, and 2 stolen bases joining fellow senior Adam Barrett as the only other Indian with 2 hits and 2 RBIs.

Brody Graper and Trent Bradshaw each drove in a pair of runs while Major Moss went 2-for-3 with 3 runs and an RBI.

The Indians jumped ahead 2-0 in the second when a leadoff double by Moss was followed by walks to Kobe Denton and Davenport to load the bases for DeVries, who doubled to right.

In the third, Barrett singled and Moss was plunked allowing Graper to knock in Barrett with a double. Moss later scored on a sacrifice fly off the bat of Bradshaw.

Leading 4-0, DeVries singled with one down in the fourth and Andrew Griffin walked, allowing Barrett to score them both on an opposite field double

Towns blew things open with four runs, all coming with two down, in the bottom of the sixth.
