Towns County Indians practice hard ahead of Golf State Tournament

WARNER ROBINS -The Towns County Golf team headed south on Sunday, May 19, for the Indians' fifth straight Georgia High School Association State Golf Tournament.

After a Third-Place finish in last year's tournament, the Indians, under second-year Head Coach Brian Hunnicutt. spent all year preparing for the event.

Leading up to the tournament, which occurred after press time, the boys had a great two weeks of practice with the team's four seniors Will Travis, Kyler Garrett, Danny Reagan and Caleb Ledford, along with a talented sophomore Nick

Sisco. "We've been putting in a steady balance of range practice and playing on the course to prepare for state," said Hunnicutt. "When we get down to Southern Landings Golf Club, we'll play a practice round, and the boys will be able to get a game plan for how we want to play the course."

The Indians teed off at 2:30 p.m. Sunday for a practice round with Hunnicutt and some of the fathers.

During the practice round Sunday, the team played really well and were able to establish their approach for each hole. Indians Golf consists of five very talented golfers, and each capable of shooting in the 70s.

"This is a balanced team that we have, and we could be the most balanced team in the state," said Hunnicutt. "We can play very well and post a great score.

"Last year, Gordon Lee shot a ridiculously low score that would have probably rivaled many college golf teams. They'll be tough again this year, but I don't think they're quite as strong."
